

## President's Welcome

Welcome to the 125th anniversary celebrations of the Basford Lawn Tennis Club. Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Club is only six years older.

We discovered our roots as a result of much searching by our longstanding member, Derek Newport, who has compiled all his findings into a booklet entitled 'A History of Basford Lawn Tennis Club 1883 – 2008' which can be purchased today at a cost of £7.00 each. It makes a fascinating read.

The Club was established in 1883 on land at the rear of the Queen's Hotel in Basford. The two courts were very near to the Etruria maril hole and one night literally disappeared. The Club moved to its current site in 1926 and was registered under the Industrial & Provident Societies Act 1893 (modified by subsequent Acts) as a business or trade which is of benefit to the community. Each full playing member owns a £1 share.

To celebrate our 125th anniversary, we have arranged for an exhibition by our juniors. Who knows we may have a Wimbledon Champion there. The last member of Basford to play in the Wimbledon Championships was Andrew Foster, in 1993, reaching the Quarter Finals where he lost to Pete Sampras when he was in his prime. We are very grateful to the Royal Air Force for being involved in our celebrations by sending ladies and men's teams to compete against our first teams and I am sure we are in for an entertaining afternoon.

All four courts are floodlit and laid with artificial sand-filled grass which is very close to playing on actual grass but have the advantage of being playable almost immediately after rain. The surface is also very kind on those aging, aching limbs. Tennis at Basford is truly all year round and caters for all levels of ability.

If you are interested in joining, the winter membership (1st October to 31st March) is available for only £80.00. Please take a membership application form available in the clubhouse.

Regrettably, I am unable to attend the celebrations due to a long standing, prior arrangement but you will be in good hands guided by the Chairman of the Management Committee, John Plumb's aplomb! I hope you have an enjoyable day and we look forward to welcoming some new faces on to our courts.

# Junior Tennis at Basford

Basford Lawn tennis club has two resident coaches in Mike Armstrong and his brother Paul. Together they deliver coaching to over 100 children both at the club and in local schools. They cater from all ages and abilities, ranging from 5 year olds just starting out with mini tennis, to the club's best juniors who compete around Staffordshire and the country.

The club has had a very successful year in terms of junior performance, with three players ranked inside the top 100 in their age group. Performances of note have come from Amy Ellis and Alex Grocott who have won several grade 3 events throughout the summer, while Josh Eardley, Hannah Parker and Ben Stannard have also done well.



Four Basford players have represented their county this year; Alex Grocott, Amy Ellis, Ben Stannard and John Thornhill. Amy and Alex also reached the national finals of the Road to Wimbledon Competition. Closer to home, Basford won the 16s and 14s North Staffs League with players such as Josh Maughan, Adam Fenton, Dan Clarke, James Belfield, Ryan Maughan and Chris Riley taking part.



As well as coaching and competitions the club also runs social events and trips. Over the past year Ace Tennis Coaching has run trips to Barcelona Tennis Academy, the Nottingham Open and Wimbledon.
